

Annual Mother's Day Prayer Walk

It has been our practice on Mother's Day Sunday to take the Cornerstone kids for a prayer walk.

I encourage you to do the same – either Sunday or another day during the week. **If you engage with this your kids will respond.**

Here are two suggestions:

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Dress for weather, if hot bring water • Walk around your neighbourhood stop and pray at people's houses <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Pray for God to protect the family that lives there ○ Pray for God to help the family show love to each other • Kids can pray silently or aloud. If they pray silent encourage them to say "Amen" when done. • If you see a bird – thank God for the beauty of creation • Find a stop sign – pray that people in your neighbourhood will "stop" and think about God • Read Ephesians 6:10-18 talk about the armour of God – the kids have been learning this. Pray that your feet will be the shoes of peace/gospel and that as you walk God's peace will spread in your neighbourhood. Walk a few house lengths. • Ephesians 6:11 instructs us to put on the armour and stand. Read the Armour of God and have kids envision putting armour on, then all stand in silence. Parent pray that God's gospel will not be defeated in your neighbourhood and that you will be the messengers of the Gospel. • As you walk draw messages of hope and love for people on the sidewalk using chalk. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Drive to City Hall – pray for the mayor and city councillors, pray for the government leaders • Drive to kids school – pray for the teachers, students and families adjusting to the new way of doing school • Drive to the church - pray for Glamorgan Church • Drive to a Senior's home – pray for the seniors who are at serious health risk for catching COVID • Drive to the Hospital – pray for the Doctor's, nurses and everyone who works at the hospital • Drive to grocery store – pray for the people who are working hard to maintain access to food and other supplies • Drive by the Drop-In Centre downtown or Mustard Seed and pray for people without homes. • Drive to a police/fire station – Pray for the police officers or firemen.
