

Jesus' First Miracle and the Reaction of the Disciples!

Read: John 2:1-11

Ask:

What did Jesus do in this story? (turned water into wine, helped the people in charge of the wedding to not be embarrassed and feel bad that they didn't have enough drinks for everyone, showed his power)

How did the disciples and everyone else react to what Jesus did? (The people were happy that Jesus made even more delicious wine than what they had before, the disciples believed in him because of the miracle)

What is something that you can learn from this story? (Jesus cared about helping people at their wedding; The disciples had a hard time believing in Jesus before he showed his power through a miracle)

Lesson:

Jesus had never shown that he could do miracles until the moment when he turned the water into wine at the wedding, but his disciples had already started to follow him. The disciples could tell that there was something special about Jesus, even though had not yet shown any miracles. Jesus must have been a really interesting person!

But it seems like the disciples only really started to believe in him once they saw this miracle.

Remember that Jesus can do miracles, but we should believe Jesus even if we don't often see miracles. The disciples started to believe in Jesus after they saw this miracle, but we can do better than that. We can believe in Jesus before we see some exciting miracle. What is one thing that you would like to ask Jesus to help with in your life? Can you put your trust in Jesus that he will help you out?

Activity:

The story today was about Jesus first miracle, and how the disciples started to believe in him when he turned water into wine. Our activity today isn't a miracle, but it sure seems like a miracle! This activity

Supplies (included):

- Miracle Berry Tablets

(not included):

- a lemon or lime

might show you how the wedding guests and the disciples felt when they expected to taste water, but instead tasted wine.

Take the MiracleBerry and put it on your tongue. Leave it there until it all dissolves (this will take about a minute or so). Now take a slice of lime/lemon (or even hot sauce!) and taste it. How does it taste? Is it what you expected? It seems like a miracle doesn't it?! It is actually a chemical reaction that makes sour things taste sweet for a little while. Imagine how surprised the disciples must have felt when Jesus turned all that water into wine to help the wedding continue without any problem.
