



## SUMMER MINISTRY POSITION

### Glamorgan Church, Calgary, AB

We are a small church with a large heart to love our neighbours. This summer's position will work in our established youth ministry and also in ministry to lower income and refugee families. Candidates will need enthusiasm and a willingness to step into the unknown as part of a team and independent of a team. This position provides an excellent opportunity to gain experience and understanding of ministry in a small church context (80 to 120 ppl).

#### **This job is dependent upon receiving Canada Summer Grant approval.**

Dates: May to August 2024 (14 weeks – start/end date flexible)  
Pay: \$17.00 hour; plus 4% vacation pay  
Hours: 35 / week (Work week is flexible, Sunday attendance/work is required)  
Deadline: Applications are accepted until March 20th  
Age: Must be under 30 years of age to qualify for Government funding and be eligible to work in Canada as per Canada Summer Grant

#### **MAIN RESPONSIBILITIES:**

- Participate in preparation, coordination and execution of youth events in May, June and July.
- Work with the Associate Pastor to support lower income families in the community of Glamorgan. Activities may include after school drop-in programs for elementary students. Meals Program, Clothing drives etc.
- Assist in Annual Stampede Breakfast (July)
- Preparation of fall curriculum for children and youth Sunday morning teaching
- Attend summer youth and children's camp (July) as a counselor or in any other role required
- Provide office support and assist with church communication including social media
- Dependent on applicant's interests further ministry opportunities may be available.

#### **QUALIFICATIONS:**

- **Leadership Skills:** assume responsibility for assigned tasks; work productively; work in a team; and, able to work independently and cooperatively with minimal supervision
- **Personal Skills:** love of children/youth, team player, responsible, accountable, friendly, enthusiastic, good time management, and committed to Christian values and principles.
- **Canadian citizens, permanent residents, or have official refugee protection status** under the Immigration and Refugee Protection Act; and be **legally entitled to work in Canada**, according to relevant provincial/territorial legislation and regulations.
